As discussed, Treasury is reviewing the information you recently provided concerning your investigation and audit of Hardest Hit Fund expenditures in Detroit, and your plans to address the issues raised thereby. In order to allow for Treasury's review and evaluation of such information, we are directing the Michigan State Housing Development Authority and the Michigan Homeowners Assistance Non-Profit Housing Corporation (collectively, Michigan) to

suspend the following activities related to blight elimination in Detroit under Michigan's Hardest Hit Fund program, until such time as Treasury notifies Michigan in writing that such activities may resume:

- Disbursement of TARP funds to Detroit and its affiliates for blight elimination, including, but not limited to, payment of invoices received from the Detroit Land Bank Authority with respect to Michigan's second and third funding allocation for Detroit.
- Approval of demolition or other blight elimination activities by Detroit or its affiliates, including, but not limited to, those related to Michigan's fourth funding allocation for Detroit.
- Execution of agreements with Detroit or its affiliates related to blight elimination, including, but not limited to, agreements with the Detroit Land Bank Authority with respect to Michigan's fifth funding allocation for Detroit.

In closing, we are committed to working with Michigan to successfully implement Michigan's Hardest Hit Fund programs. We will endeavor to respond as promptly as possible so as to minimize any disruption to its blight elimination programs.

For the sake of clarity, this correspondence constitutes a notice delivered pursuant to Section 8 of the Commitment to Purchase Financial Instrument and HFA Participation Agreement, dated as of June 23, 2010, between Treasury and Michigan (as amended from time to time).
